- ⑧ Leagues begin Thursday, October 1, 2009
- ⑧ Roster deadline September 25, 2009
- ⑧ Register on line – (Betty's most favorite way!), emailed, faxed. Entry forms available here, online and sponsoring locations. Final roster deadline is December 1st. You can have up to 10 on a roster. **Complete names and addresses are needed along with email addresses if you have it.**

- ⑧ Game format is 5 player – 25 game format No limitation regarding rank in this league.
- ⑧ Open leagues- Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday; Tuesday is split into four divisions. There is a new rank, BB. Tuesday will have 4 leagues, AA, A, BB and B. Limited to one upper ranked player on a team. Wednesday is limited to 2 AA players and only 1 AA can shoot per match.
- ⑧ Watch for Monday 3-player 18-game format next year
- ⑧ Sunday Young @ Heart; Friday Mixed Scotch Doubles to be offered later in the season

- ⑧ Current penalty for a forfeit is zero 8-ball points, 0-6 round loss, 0-25 game loss.
- ⑧ Reschedule policy – original no-show will receive forfeit if unable to reschedule. A no show/no notice will be forfeited and the forfeiting team will pay both teams player fees
- ⑧ When rescheduling a match, the other team captain **AND** league office **MUST** be notified
- ⑧ The league office has the right to reschedule a match

- ⑧ League will be handicapped. For your first week's match, the averages from last year will carry-over. If no average, it will be based on player's rank (M=10, A=9, A=8, B/BB=7). If no average or rank, men will receive an 8, women 6.
- ⑧ There will NOT be playoffs in the league.

- ⑧ Schedules will be done 1-2 days prior to your start date. Packets will be delivered to your sponsoring locations prior to the first night of play. Captains will be notified by phone where their first night of play is.
- ⑧ Scoresheet collection, the visiting team is responsible for taking the envelope to the drop location. Partners Pub will be a Sartell drop. Late fees \$5, after 3rd time it goes up to \$10. Shortages are the visiting teams captains. The only exception is when you are playing a match at a drop location, the home team is responsible. Score sheets should be signed by both team captains after the match, verify the money and **both team captains should keep a carbon copy of the match scores**
- ⑧ Awards – voted no
- ⑧ A traveling trophy is awarded to the 1st place team for your league. The winner of the traveling trophy was Ducks MN Pulverizers.

- ⑧ Standings mailed or delivered weekly or www.mwcoin.com. League #1208. **Get email addresses for players and/or locations to the league office for standing distribution and other league information.**
- ⑧ Fees: Secretary Fees will be \$35.00 per team.
- ⑧ Sanction fees are \$11.00 per player, covers VNEA, local and MOMA state fees. Do NOT send in your sanction fees into our office directly, they will be deducted at the end of the league season from your payback check.
- ⑧ ACS Sanctioning was offered and **DECLINED**
- ⑧ Player Fees: \$5.00 per player per week. **Voted**
- ⑧ Start time for league will be 7:30 p.m.
- ⑧ Captains Guides- Page 15 for Personal Check Policy. Credit or debit cards accepted. Personal information is destroyed after card is run. Sponsor checks are still accepted. VNEA and MCC captains guide will be in your packet. Rack your own rack will be required.
