Agenda Items:

- ⑧ Leagues begin Monday, October 5, 2009
- ⑧ Roster deadline is, September 25, final roster deadline is January 1, Game format is 4 player – 16 game format
- ⑧ Handicapping – Use carry over from last year (08-09) for average. Last year's final standings will be included in the packets. If no average, women will have a 6, men an 8. Maximum handicap is 10 points/round, 40/match
- ⑧ Rosters are available at sponsoring locations, at the meeting and online @ www.mwcoin.com.
- ⑧ Player mailing goes to all players had a meeting calendar on the back. Be sure our office has your correct address. Also an email address and standings can be emailed to you.
- ⑧ No limit on the number of Masters shooters on any teams in the league
- ⑧ Schedules will be done 1-2 days prior to your start date. **League #1210**. Packets will be delivered to your sponsoring locations prior to the first night of play. Captains will be notified by phone where their first night of play is. Leave the packets at the bar.
- ⑧ Award - "Sharpshooter Award" Last year's winner was Steve Christenson. Highest average, play 80% of the league.
- ⑧ A traveling trophy is awarded to the 1st place team for your league, not for your playoff. The winner of the traveling trophy was VFW Guilt By Association.
- ⑧ Score sheets should be signed by both team captains after the match, verify the money and **both team captains should keep a carbon copy of the match scores. Home team is responsible to mail in.** Mail the white copy and include check, not cash, for player fees. Late fee is \$5.00.
- ⑧ Standings distributed to the bar and at website www.mwcoin.com If email is provided, they will be emailed to you also.
- ⑧ Fees: Secretary Fees will be \$35.00 per team.
- ⑧ Sanction fees are \$11.00 for VNEA, Local and MOMA. One week of play a player is sanctioned. Do NOT send in your sanction fees into our office directly, they will be deducted at the end of the league season from your payback check. If you are short a player, don't grab someone that will only play one week, play short so you don't have sanction fees for that player..
- ⑧ ACS Sanctioning was offered and *DECLINED*
- ⑧ Player Fees: \$5.00 per player per week.
- ⑧ Pool tables are \$1.50
- ⑧ Payback Money:
 - 70% to 8 Ball points
 - 30% Playoffs
- ⑧ Start time for league will be 7:30 p.m., 15 minute grace period. Must start with 3 players present. You must contact your opponent 3 hours prior if you cannot make the match; **YOU MUST ALSO CONTACT THE LEAGUE OFFICE. New pool committee decision:** If a team is a no-show and does not reschedule the match, they will pay both teams' league fees for the night.
- ⑧ Captains Guides- Page 15 for Personal Check Policy. Credit or debit cards accepted. Personal information is destroyed after card is run. Sponsor checks are still accepted. VNEA and MCC captains guide will be in your packet.
- ⑧ Rack your own rack will be mandatory this year.
- ⑧ Scratch on the 8 is not a loss unless you make the 8.
- ⑧ Playoffs - Eligibility is 5 weeks of play – 10 games. Playoffs will be scheduled to play out on Monday evenings **In a tie-breaker, last round is played over, alternate breaks with home starting.**

- ⑧ Cue ball lending program – there will be a form in your packet, no charge if returned, if you want to buy it, it is \$22.50
- ⑧ Rankings this year are AA, A, BB, B. The BB was added this year to the leagues. The BB was added at last year's MCC tournament. If you don't like your ranking, send in a ranking review form. (This is for MCC ranking only). Your rankings will be on your standings.
