⑧ New for 2009-2010 Tuesday Leagues

A 4<sup>th</sup> Division (BB) has been added, Tuesday will now have Open AA, A, BB, and B leagues. Requirements for these leagues are:

Open AA – 2 or more AA players on the roster, must play in this division

Open A – Allowed 1 AA player on roster

Open BB – Allowed 1 A player on roster

Open B – Allowed 1 BB player on roster

Rankings based on **single ranking** in the 2009-2010 Classification List

“Grandfathered In” teams – no longer guaranteed. League Dept reserve the right based on team/players knowability to either bump or keep down a level, regardless of ranking.

Teams winning league championships in the A or B Divisions will be bumped a level for a 2-year term, depending on league size, scheduling conflicts, etc.

Team can chose to play up a division, but not allowed to drop down unless ranking requirements would allow.

⑧ MOMA, ACS and VNEA override MCC rankings

⑧ Monday Wednesday and Thursday leagues also available

⑧ Wednesday Open is now limited to 2 AA on a roster, only allowed to use 1 in a match

⑧ Roster deadline is, September 25, 2009.

⑧ **Complete names and addresses are needed. Please provide email address if you would like updated league information throughout the league season.**

⑧ Schedules will be done 1-2 days prior to your start date. Packets will be delivered to your sponsoring locations prior to the first night of play. Captains will be notified by phone where their first night of play is.

- ⑧ Awards available through the league office at the players expense. This was voted against. The traveling trophy was awarded to Ducks Terminators (Gold, now AA), Moose Lodge Rack 'Em Up (A) and Red Carpet Quantum Mechanics (B).
- ⑧ See pages 10-11 of your captain's guide. Drop off envelopes at participating drop location. Visiting team is responsible for dropping the envelope. Score sheets should be signed by both team captains after the match, verify the money and **both team captains should keep a carbon copy of the match scores**
- ⑧ Standing distribution will be mailed or delivered to your sponsoring locations and also available on our website at [www.mwcoin.com](http://www.mwcoin.com). If emails are given, standings can also be emailed.
- ⑧ Fees: Secretary Fees will be \$35.00 per team.
- ⑧ Sanction fees are \$11.00 per player. This covers VNEA, Local MCC and MOMA state. Do NOT send in your sanction fees into our office directly, they will be deducted at the end of the league season from your payback check.
- ⑧ **ACS Sanctioning was offered and voted on as:**
  - AA – Yes**
  - A - No**
  - BB – No**
  - B -- No**
- ⑧ Player Fees: \$5.00 per player per week.
- ⑧ Payback Money – voted as follows:
  - AA – split 50% games won, 50% playoffs**
  - A, BB, B – 40% 8 ball points, 30% league ranking, 30% playoffs**
- ⑧ Start time for league will be 7:30 p.m.
- ⑧ Captains Guides- Page 15 for Personal Check Policy. Credit or debit cards accepted. Personal information is destroyed after card is run. Sponsor checks are still accepted. VNEA and MCC captains guide will be in your packet.
- ⑧ Playoffs:
  - Eligibility is 5 weeks of play
  - AA will play out on Tuesdays with a double header at the beginning
  - A, BB, & B would like the last teams in it to take a vote to either play out on Tuesday or take to a final Saturday
