Agenda Items:

- ⑧ Introduction – Fantasee football
- ⑧ Leagues begin Wednesday, October 7, 2009
- ⑧ MOMA, ACS and VNEA rankings override MCC rankings.
- ⑧ Open leagues- Monday, Tuesday and Thursday - New ranking and league on Tuesday:
A 4th Division (BB) has been added, Tuesday will now have Open AA, A, BB, and B leagues. Requirements for these leagues are:
 - Open AA – 2 or more AA players on the roster, must play in this division
 - Open A – Allowed 1 AA player on roster
 - Open BB – Allowed 1 A player on roster
 - Open B – Allowed 1 BB player on roster
- ⑧ 5 Player, 25 game format. Limited to two AA on a team. No Masters. Limited to 1 AA player per match. Masters ranks at the state level, Midwest Coin is highest ranking is AA. Voted to leave as is.
- ⑧ Will be a Sunday Young @ Heart starting later in the year.
- ⑧ Next year a Monday night 3-player 18 game format will be offered.
- ⑧ Roster deadline is, September 25th. Register online at www.mwcoin.com. You can also email roster or fax your roster. Fax # is 251-6093. Also can pick up rosters at sponsoring locations. League #1207.
- ⑧ Complete names and addresses are needed along with email addresses if you have it. Final Roster deadline December 1, 2009. VNEA sanctioning is done 12/15 of each year.
- ⑧ Scheduling is done 1 to 2 days prior to start date. Reason is because of late rosters coming in. Captains called with first night's match. Packets delivered to sponsoring location.
- ⑧ **Will** have Wednesday before Thanksgiving off.
- ⑧ Awards or trophies are available to the league's expense. Voted not to have out of league expense.
- ⑧ A new traveling trophy was ordered and awarded to the 1st place team for your league, not for your playoff. The winner of the traveling trophy was Jimmy's Big Balls.

- ⑧ Score sheets should be signed by both team captains after the match, verify the money and both team captains should keep a carbon copy of the match scores. There will be a list of locations to drop off in your packet. A late fee of \$5 will be charged for late score sheets. Please keep the carbon copy of your match. This will ensure that the standings are current in case of a missing score sheet. Please remember to drop at location, not mail your envelopes. Visiting team is responsible for envelope unless at a drop location.
- ⑧ Standings, mailed or delivered weekly depending on where you are at. Also available on website. If email is provided they will be emailed to you.
- ⑧ Fees: Secretary Fees will be \$35.00 per team. Comes out of the check at the end of the season.
- ⑧ Sanction fees are \$11.00 per player, includes VNEA, MOMA and local. Those that played summer league will have already paid sanction fees. Sanction fees are one time per year per player. If you play in more than one league, your sanction fee will come out of your main team. Sanction fees are taken out of the end of league season check.
- ⑧ ACS Sanctioning was offered and *DECLINED*
- ⑧ Player Fees: \$5.00 per player per week. Voted to keep.
- ⑧ Payback Money:
 - Last year 40% league ranking, 20% playoffs, 40% 8-ball points
 - Voted to keep same payouts and pay everyone playing in playoffs.
 - This year's playoffs will be Luck Of The Draw. A team from the lower 8 will be matched with a team from the upper 8 and so on. Bracket will play out from there.
- ⑧ Playoffs:
 - Eligibility is 5 weeks of play (15 games)
 - Playoffs will be scheduled right away and can be found at the end of your regular league schedule.
- ⑧ Start time for league will be 7:30 p.m., 15 minute grace. If 3 players present, must start
- ⑧ Captains Guides- Page 15 for Personal Check Policy. Credit or debit cards accepted. Personal information is destroyed after card is run. Sponsor checks are still accepted. VNEA and MCC captains guide will be in your packet.
- ⑧ Rack your own rack will be mandatory this year.
