Agenda Items:

- ⑧ Introduction, Betty Benoit – League Coordinator, Heidi Newman – League Secretary
- ⑧ Leagues begin June 9th or 10th, Tuesday and Wednesday @ 8:00
- ⑧ New scoresheets format for the Tuesday 18 game was introduced and reviewed by players present. You may still use a rotation, and a sample copy will be enclosed in your packets
- ⑧ Tuesdays scoresheet will continue to count as (2) weeks of play, since we combined the scoresheet this year.
- ⑧ Ties for both Tuesday and Wednesday will be scored as a ½ round per team. Do NOT break ties using the most 10's per round.
- ⑧ Tuesday leagues will continue to sanction with both VNEA, ACS as well as the local.
- ⑧ Wednesday leagues will **VOTE** on ACS Sanctioning once the league has started.
- ⑧ Handicap for summer league was **DECLINED**.
- ⑧ No roster limit or Final Deadline Date for summer league. Players can be added at anytime. Complete names and addresses are needed along with email addresses if you have it, especially the captain, that's who the check gets sent. Only one person (captain) can be listed on the check due to strict bank policies.
- ⑧ Roster deadline is Monday, June 1st.
- ⑧ Game format is 3 player – 18 game format for Tuesday and Wednesday 4 player – 16 game format
- ⑧ Schedules will be done 1-2 days prior to your start date. Packets will be delivered to your sponsoring locations prior to the first night of play. Captains will be notified by phone where their first night of play is.
- ⑧ Payback Money:
 - Tuesday: Deduct a portion of the league fees for a final singles tournament at the end of the league season. In 2008, \$500 was reserved for the mini's and the remainder paid out on 8 Ball Point Payback. Players present voted to continue the payback in the same manner.
 - Wednesday: **Vote payback monies after league begins, samples of ways to payback your money will be sent in ballot form. Captains were reminded to be sure to respond with a vote.**
- ⑧ Player Fees: \$5.00 per player per week
- ⑧ Score sheets are collected via the mail in system. Do not use the drop locations, be extra careful not to accidentally use a drop envelope from the Fall/Winter season and send it through the mail as they will not arrive at the league office...If you drop them at a location, call Betty at 258.5952 so we can send someone out to pick them up. Home Teams are responsible to mail in the envelope the day following the match. If envelopes are not postmarked the following day and are received late, our office charges \$5.00 for each late envelope, \$10.00 after the 3rd incident. Postage paid envelopes will be provided in your captains packets. **DO NOT SEND CASH IN THE MAIL!!! Please write a check for your league fees payable to Midwest Coin Concepts.**

- ⑧ ***Score sheets should be signed by both team captains after the match, verify the money and both team captains should keep a carbon copy of the match scores***
- ⑧ Fees: **Secretary Fees will be waived for the Summer Pool League programs.**
- ⑧ Sanction fees are ACS at \$10.00, VNEA is \$7.00 and MCC/MOMA will be \$3.00. A player is sanctioned after (1) week of play, please be careful when adding subs to your roster.
- ⑧ Nightly player fees are \$5.00 per person
- ⑧ Table fees remain the same at \$1.50 per game of pool. We recommend that players split the quarters each game. Each team on Tuesday then pays \$13.50, and on Wednesday each team pays \$12.00
- ⑧ Start time for league will be 8:00 p.m.
- ⑧ Standings will be distributed by mail to the sponsoring location, e-mailed to the captains, and on our website at www.mwcoin.com. Tuesday's league # is 1200 and Wednesday is 1220.
- ⑧ **Players please watch for upcoming ranking changes for the 2009 – 2010 League Season. Tuesday evening will now have St Cloud Tuesday Open AA, A, BB, and B Divisions. Changes are forthcoming, watch our website for details! Target date of August 15th for the updates!**
- ⑧ **Website Changes: Meeting Minutes and Financial Statements have been added for your review for all of our leagues. Be sure to check them out, all of your league information at your fingertips.**
